Citizens League is proud to host the **Minnesota Legislative Exchange (MLE)** - a first-in-the-nation effort to bridge divides, build trust and intentionally foster bipartisan relationships. Through the MLE, one Republican and one Democratic member of the Minnesota State Legislature are paired up to visit each other's districts, where they spend time together while learning more about each other and their communities.



Since its founding in 2016, the **Capitol Pathways internship program** has become a flagship program of the Citizens League. The program provides BIPOC college students with hands-on leadership, legislative and career readiness training alongside a paid policy internship with partnering organizations. With over 340 alumni, Capitol Pathways is bringing new leaders and change-makers into policymaking spaces at local, state and national levels.



Citizens League promotes a **variety of opportunities for Minnesotans to learn and increase their engagement** through a nonpartisan approach that represents diverse points of view. Through our Interconnected Rural-Urban Conversations (a collaborative with the Center for Rural Policy and Development), Mind Openers, Civics@Work, and other events, Citizens League works to increase awareness and civic participation.
